Dr. Michael Baden - Keynote Speaker

Michael M. Baden is an American physician and board-certified forensic pathologist known for his work investigating high-profile deaths and as the host of HBO's *Autopsy.* He is considered controversial, and has on a number of occasions been on the opposite side of many experts in his line of work. In October 2019, Baden was hired by Jeffrey Epstein's brother, and observed

the autopsy done by city officials following Epstein's death. Baden disputed New York City chief medical examiner Barbara Sampson's conclusion that Epstein's

death was a suicide, asserting that three fractures in Epstein's neck were more consistent with homicide by strangulation and rarely seen in suicide by hanging. His opinion on the case has been disputed.



Dominick J. Astorino

Dominick J. Astorino is an adjunct professor of mortuary science both at Worsham College of Mortuary Science in Chicago and Wayne State University in Detroit where he wrote and teaches courses in embalming, restorative art, pathology and microbiology. Innovations such as the creation of a hands-on cranial reconstruction lab as well as teaching advanced techniques by applying basic principles have earned him accolades and awards from students and colleagues

alike. His work in the field of restorative art and reconstructive embalming has been highlighted in numerous publications worldwide as well as by invitations to present lectures across the US, Canada, Europe, Africa, Asia and the Caribbean.



Jan Hargrave

Working with thousands in the field of personal growth and self-expression through seminars and workshops for the past 10 years, Ms. Hargrave continues to inspire many of today's leading corporations. Her expertise concerning nonverbal communication in the courtroom and witness preparation, plus her membership in the American College of Forensic Examiners, proves to be the topics of interest in

her presentations across the country. Nonverbal communication - "Body Language"- often communicates a different message from the spoken word. Bring your body, your curiosity, your sense of humor and learn what your body - and the body of others - is communicating to the world.



Allison Gilbert

Allison Gilbert is an Emmy award-winning journalist and one of the most thought-provoking and influential writers on grief and resilience. Gilbert is a popular workshop leader and keynote speaker, presenting to such groups as NFDA, ICCFA, and Google. Her presentation will focus on practical and innovative opportunities to increase community

engagement around commemoration. It will also reveal strategies for developing successful local and regional partnerships.
