



Dear Motor Carrier,

Your operations may be exempt from the NYSDOT Bus Inspection Program if you are not transporting passengers for compensation or conducting school-related transportation. You may also be exempt if you are transporting passengers for compensation, but only doing so in such a manner that meets any of the exemptions listed in Section 151 of the New York State Transportation Law.

To request an exemption letter, please submit the following information by e-mail to NYSDOTExemptionRequest@dot.ny.gov or by fax to (518) 485-0257:

- 1. A statement *clearly specifying* what you use the vehicle for and whether compensation is provided, either directly or indirectly, for this transportation.
- 2. Your full name.
- 3. The legal business name of the organization operating the vehicle, if applicable.
- 4. A statement that you have the authority to act on behalf of the organization, if applicable.
- 5. A state-issued document (title, prior registration, etc.) showing the vehicle's information.
- 6. Vehicle Information:
 - a. Vehicle Identification Number (VIN)
 - b. Year
 - c. Make
 - d. Model
 - e. Color
 - f. Adult seating capacity as specified on final manufacturer's label or tire rating label.
 - i. Typically found in the driver-side door jamb.
 - ii. Includes the driver's seat.

7. For Stretch Limousines

- a. Pictures of the vehicle's exterior.
- b. Pictures of the vehicle's interior showing all fitted seats.
- c. Pictures of the vehicle's final manufacturer's label and tire rating label.
 - i. Typically found in the driver-side door jamb.

Warning -- This exemption letter only applies to the NYSDOT Bus Inspection Program and does not exempt you from FMCSA requirements, if applicable. This includes registering for a USDOT Number as well as CDL requirements for drivers.
